# ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD'EM

## THE BASICS

The game is a modified version of Texas Hold'Em in which the Players and Dealers share 5 community cards in conjunction with their own 2 cards. The Dealer will give you 2 cards which you can choose to either play or fold during 3 betting rounds.

## HOW TO PLAY

- ◆ Get into the game by placing a wager in the Ante and blind betting areas before “no more bets” is called.
- ◆ Once bets are placed, you will receive 2 cards face down and the Dealer will also receive two cards face down.
- ◆ If you decide to wager on your hand at this point, you will need to place a Play bet equal to three or four times your Ante wager. If you decide not to bet at this point, you may check (bet nothing).
- ◆ The Dealer will now burn one card, and reveal the next 3 cards in the deck that will be used as community cards, that is everyone gets to use these cards to make a 5 card poker hand.
- ◆ Once again, the option of wagering on your hand is now available. At this point of the game, a Play wager of twice your Ante wager is required. Of course, you may choose to check again at this point of the game as well.
- ◆ The Dealer will once again burn a card and reveal the next 2 cards in the deck. This will complete the 5 community cards that both the Players and the Dealer will use to make the best 5 card poker hand in conjunction with their own two cards.
- ◆ Now if you choose to play against the Dealer, you will need to make a Play wager that is equal to your Ante wager. If you don't wish to play against the Dealer, your hand will be folded, and you lose all your wagers.
- ◆ Once everyone at the table has chosen to fold or play, the Dealer will turn over his/her 2 remaining cards.
- ◆ If the Dealer has a pair or higher, the Dealer will play the hand and compare it to the other hands at the table.
- ◆ If your hand beats the Dealer's hand, you win! Your winning bet will be paid even money (1 to 1) on your Ante and play wagers. The maximum payout limit is \$2000 per hand.
- ◆ If the Dealer's hand does not contain a pair or higher, your Ante wager will push (neither win nor lose), and no action will be taken on the bet wager.

- ◆ If your hand ties the Dealer's qualifying hand (all five cards are identical in rank regardless of suit), you keep your Ante and bet wagers.
- ◆ All maximum and minimum table limits are posted at each table.

### **BLIND WAGER PAYOUTS**

- ◆ Blind wagers will be a push if the player's hand is three of a kind or less. Players will be paid according to the following payable if their hand is a straight or better on the blind wager and outranks the dealer hand.

#### **PAYOUT**

Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
Four of a Kind	10 to 1
Full House	3 to 1
Flush	3 to 2
Straight	1 to 1

### **TRIP BONUS PAYOUTS**

Trip Bonus wagers are paid independent of dealer player outcome. The Trip Bonus payouts are as follows.

#### **PAYOUT**

Royal Flush	50 to 1
Straight Flush	40 to 1
Four of a Kind	30 to 1
Full House	8 to 1
Flush	7 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Three of a Kind (Trips)	3 to 1
